 <p>Cleaning your child's teeth</p> <p>Start cleaning your child's teeth as soon as they come through. Use a clean cloth or a small, soft toothbrush to clean the gums and teeth.  <p>Lift the Lip Check your child's teeth regularly for signs of tooth decay. If you notice any changes, book a dental appointment.</p> <p>Healthy baby teeth First dental visits are still recommended at 12-18 months.</p> <p>White lines on the top front teeth are the gum line call for the beginning of tooth decay.  <p>Pregnancy and your oral health During pregnancy, hormonal changes may increase your risk of tooth decay and gum disease.</p> <p>Keep your teeth and gums healthy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Brush your teeth and gums in the morning and at night. Use a small, soft toothbrush and a pea-sized amount of fluoride toothpaste. After brushing, spit out the toothpaste but don't rinse with water. Drink clean tap water. Avoid frequent snacking on sweet foods and drinks. If you're a smoker, think about quitting. Call the Quilline on 13 78 48. Visit your dentist for a check-up.  <p>Stop tooth decay Tooth decay happens when plaque bacteria in the mouth combine with sugar and make acid.
